Coping Baghjan Inferno

The Baghjan incidence has stopped/ disrupted production operations at Oil India Limited's 33 Oil wells and 5 Gas wells in NE India. As on June 20, 2020, the company reported production loss of 585 MT of Crude Oil and 0.64 MMSCM of Natural Gas. The cumulative production loss since blowout on May 27, 2020 due to bandhs and blockades is around 8013 MT Crude oil, 10.24 MMSCM of natural gas
