DEW Journal has Three Supplements published periodically over the year as below:

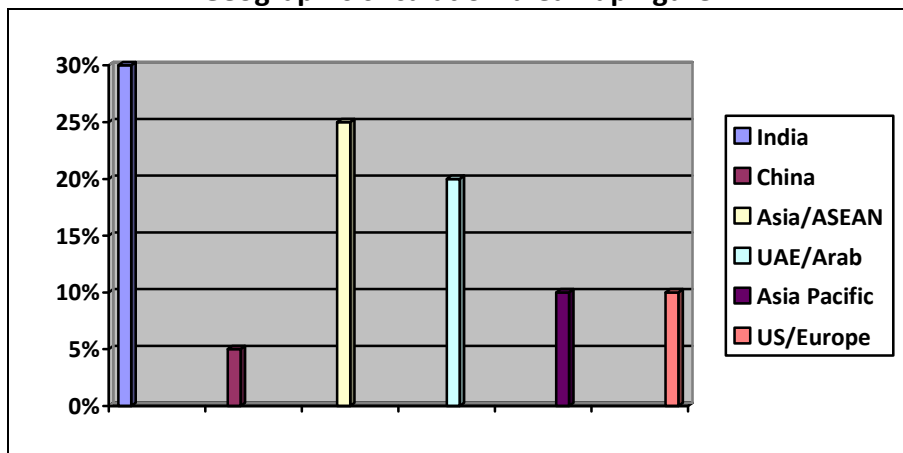

Geographic circulation break-up figure:

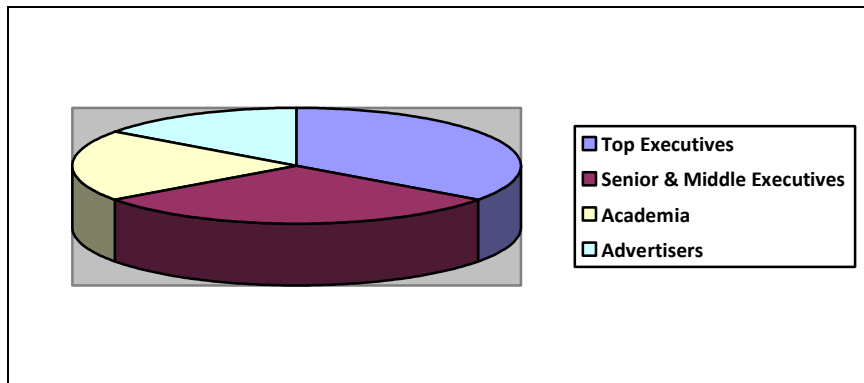


Readers Profile
