

Sweden joins the International Solar Alliance

Sweden has ratified and deposited the framework agreement of the International Solar Alliance (ISA), and its Membership of the International Solar Alliance entered into force on 17 July 2021

Speaking about Sweden's membership, Ambassador Klas Molin said, "Sweden is happy to join the International Solar Alliance. Prime Minister Löfven reiterated to Prime Minister Modi the need for enhanced global cooperation at their last meeting.
